With nine Galoppen events in the 2019 calendar down ten in 2018, the expectations were for the four clubs to post slightly lower Borrowdale Trophy scores as fewer scorers would achieve five counting scores. Across the board, though, two club's achieved higher scores whilst two saw their scores reduce, so overall a good performance.

WCOC take the win for the third year running, with their score of 14830 up by 100 from 2017. LOC (winners in 2016) are second again with a dramatically reduced score, down by 2105 (1/6th) from their 12658 in 2018, with reductions on all courses except Brown and big reductions on the shorter courses. BL are third, increasing their score yet again from 9452 in 2018 to 10276, an increase of 824 that brings them to only 277 behind LOC; maybe a challenge for second place in 2020? WAROC, the smallest competing club, reduced their score slightly, down from 3332 to 3030, a modest reduction of 302.
